Raising, training and donating guide dogs to blind people

Puppy socializing

12 puppies entered the first stage of their training as guide dogs, where they learn to live together in the social environment; obey simple orders; eat and go to the bathroom at set times; and, walk with a necklace and a strap. This stage was carried out in two ways:

Temporary adoption

Three volunteer families in their home and social environment collaborated in the socialization of **3** puppies, teaching them to live in the human environment.

Socialization at school

Trainers, social service providers and visitors who carried out socialization activities with **11** puppies inside and outside the school.



450 socialization sessions for 11 dogs.

67 specialized training sessions for 11 dogs.



Specialized training

11 adult dogs are in this stage where they learn to obey more complex commands (walk on the left side; deflect obstacles; wear their harness; get on public transport; find: doors, stairs, sidewalks and chairs; cross streets; and, have a exemplary behavior).



Dogs removed from Training

Jacky, Kira, Lord and **Nala** were placed in definitive adoption as companion dogs, because during training, they did not develop the skills to be guide dogs.

Training for blind people in the handling of guide dogs (Training of Binomials)

3 people received a guide dog as a donation. From February 10 to March 9, **127** training sessions were conducted for blind people in handling guide dogs. For 27 days the candidates stayed at the school receiving each **3** meals a day.

At the graduation of pairs that took place on March 2 at the school facilities, **170** people attended, including; Inclusive rehabilitation users and guide dogs, donors, adoptive families, Veterinary Hospital clients and the media.

During the event, awareness activities were carried out: eating breakfast blindly, using the computer without the mouse, writing their names in Braille and socializing with our future puppies, guide dogs.





16 blind and low vision people aged **26** to **80** years received:

59 individual sessions of psychological support, so that they can overcome grief and recognize their disability as one more physical characteristic.

221 Orientation and mobility sessions where users develop orientation skills using the white cane so they can move from one place to another autonomously.

185 sessions of Activities of daily living, providing them with tools and techniques that allow them to safely, independently and effectively carry out the activities of their daily lives.

120 Computing classes that by teaching the use of talking screen reader software, our users learn to use any computer or mobile device.
